JULY 2021 PROGRAM CHANGES

As we navigate a return to on-site operations at Audio-Reader, some changes to the Program Schedule are taking place.

Book Club and **History Book Hour** will no longer be broadcast. Those hours are another chance to hear the Non-Fiction Book Hour & Armchair Adventure Hour.

Non-fiction Book Hour is now 7 days a week at 7PM, with a repeat broadcast at 4AM.

Armchair Adventure Hour continues 7 days a week, with a repeat broadcast at 5AM.

Mystery Hour continues daily at 11PM (no repeat).
